Sign up for our **Liner Recycling** service when you order your labels



Rapid Labels prints and supplies your labels to you



You apply the labels to your product



We collect your box once it is full; contact us to arrange a pick up



Following our **Recycling Rules**, you begin storing the liner waste



We send you Rapid's Liner Recycling box and pallet



Rapid sends an invoice with confirmed freight and handling fees before sending a replacement box and pallet.



Liner is shipped to our Liner Recycling Partner



Liner is recycled in India and it is used to make high quality tissue paper

# Glassine Liner Recycling

## Storage Rules and Pricing



**Storage Rules:** Please follow these storage rules to ensure that there is no contamination during the recycling process.

**Packaging Specs:** We recommend you use the **Rapid Labels Liner Box and pallet** as there are strict requirements for each.



**White Glassine Liner only** – no coloured, kraft or plastic liner



**Liner must be free of all:** labels, adhesive and plastic material



**Tightly wind liner** – with, or without cores. Loose liner requires compacting



**Liner must be clean, dry and free of contaminates**

**The Box:** The Rapid Liner Recycling box has been designed for optimal stacking in shipping containers.

**There are strict requirements for this box:**

- It must be stored on heat treated export grade pallets
- It must have a lid
- The box must be a maximum size of: 1.16m (L) x 1.16m (W) x 1.0m (H)
- It must not overhang the pallet
- The maximum height of the box stacked on a pallet is 1.15m (including the pallet)
- The filled box must be a minimum of 500kg and a maximum of 1000kg
- The boxes must be strong enough to support being double stacked

**The Pallet:** The use of a Rapid Liner Recycling approved pallet is strongly recommended. Any pallets that do not conform will require rework onto approved pallets at an additional cost.

**There are strict requirements for pallets:**

- Pallets must be heat treated (export grade: ISPM15)
- Pallet size for New Zealand must be 1.0m (L) x 1.2m (W)
