Just as well we're geared to react quickly because that's what has been needed this year.

Throughout this year we had service milestones of 5 years for Gwen, Nick, Kevin, Gareth, Galoto, Sheila, Teake, Peter and Angela, 10 years for Tony, Fehala, Tim and Mal, and a creditable 15 years for lati, Tai and Janine.

Ace and Gareth completed their Print Apprenticeships this year and attended their graduation ceremony in June. Yong was the winner of our marathon 2012 NRL competition and he took away the coveted Rotometrics sponsored prize of an iPad.

Things started to hot-up in the middle of the year. At Pride in Print in June, we won four gold medals and Label of the Year. We were suitably chuffed with that result so you can imagine the cheer from 25 (well dressed) Rapid employees when the Apprentice of the Year was announced to be one of our own too. Congratulations to Gareth, what a fabulous achievement. He didn't stop there either, in September he went on to win the ANZFTA (Australasian Flexo) Award too. And the news just got bigger. July was our first month under new ownership! We are now part of the Tiri Group, majority-owned by Tom Sturgess (who was our owner back in the day of Blue Star Print Group). Kevin, Rob and Greg are also our Tiri owners and managers and we are very pleased to say that we are now privately and locally owned by people who have known and loved us and wanted to come back for more!

Congratulations also to Alex who bravely added number three to his brood (the beautiful Layla) in April, to Stacy who became a first time Dad this year (Donovan was born in May) and to PC on his second daughter, Isla, born in September.

September saw us release a new uncoated wine stock called Takaka, a new 3D foiling effect called Sculpted Foil and we presented our NZ International Wine Show Rapid Labels Trophy to Waimea Gewurztraminer.

We were very pleased to report in October that we set a sales record of \$2.26m which was 18% better than the previous October. Having a best-ever month in these patchy economic times is a feat and we were rapt with the result. Also in October Tony raced around Thailand/UK/Netherlands/Poland/Malaysia to assess new machinery.

In barcode printers we have been reconfirming our 23 year commitment to the Zebra brand. Stacy attended the Australia/New Zealand Zebra conference in March, we had ZASP training for Julie, Ernie, David and Stacy in July, and Anne-Marie attended the Zebra Asia Pacific conference in Guiyang, China in November.

We achieved FSC (Forestry Stewardship Council) certification which was a first for a NZ label manufacturer. We also signed up to a deal which sees us stay in our current building in Armstrong Road, Albany until 2020.

And if all that wasn't enough, we transitioned to our own in-house IT system in November. A new phone system and upgrades in our Prepress area are also to follow in December. Phew.

We're planning and preparing new initiatives and equipment in 2013 and look forward to the New Year with enthusiasm. But first, a relaxing lunch with the crew on 21 December, and a holiday break to re-charge the batteries.
